- "The company culture here is unlike any other I have seen. Everyone here is so passionate about Radio Flyer and loves seeing people succeed as well as the company. Questions are welcome and so is team collaboration to complete tasks and projects. The company is very diligent with training and tries getting me involved in as much as possible, without overwhelming me. They also care a lot about professional/personal development and there are classes throughout that are there to learn."
- "Radio Flyer is an incredibly supportive and fun place to work. From the beginning, my manager set very clear expectations and has supported me on meeting those. I am required to work 40 hours, and no more time is expected of me. There is also an half-day Friday option available for all Flyers, including interns, and folks are very open to time off as needed for out of work events."
- "The culture at Radio Flyer plays an integral role in the company. Even from a remote internship, the company's culture was very strong and clear which made me want to accept a full-time offer. The added benefit of summer hours also helped guide me through my internship."

- "While there overall stat for men and women is equal, it is skewed tremendously. Nearly the entire HR, sales, and marketing departments are female, and the engineering departments are nearly all male.

 They do not have very many people with color or any disabled people. They are being very proactive about changing this though!"
- "Almost the entire finance team I work with is composed of women. Half of the team are also members of an underrepresented racial and ethnic group. We have open discussions about DE&I often and in everyday conversations."
- "The intern group is not super racially diverse. This is an area that they have acknowledged, and are working to improve."
- "There is always room to improve and become more inclusive to everyone. Radio Flyer has classes/work sessions to discuss DE&I and ensure that each person is upholding the company values when it comes to being inclusive for everyone."

- "It was great to get to know all full-time employees and internships on a personal level and have the opportunity to work with any of them. Radio Flyer encourages communication, collaboration, and dedication through company classes and workshops related to communication styles, getting to know the CWO, and respecting and encouraging diversity and inclusion."
- "The best aspects of the internship were that I got to wear so many different hats in the role. Even as an intern, I worked on a variety of different projects and I got to see them in real time and the effects they had on the company. I was doing real design work with professionals and still felt supported and valued as an equal rather than a new intern."
- "I am so impressed how strong the vision mission and values are. A culture of integrity and respect is emphasized in all things and company events. I feel that I was able to form a solid vision of the kind of business person I would like to be. I appreciated the ability to see a variety of different financial/accounting processes. The finance team welcomed me as a member of the team and I felt I was doing productive work that was satisfying."
- "Radio Flyer has the most beautiful and fun office I've ever seen. I get to do lots of real engineering jobs, my design is being prototyped and will be manufactured and sold in actual supermarkets and websites, which makes me feel meaningful working as an intern in RF."

- "I didn't find all my projects to be the most exciting, but I also feel that this was an important lesson to learn about industry careers: how to balance a range of varying projects and make sure everything, not just the 'fun' projects, gets finished at a high quality."
- "Remote/in-person interaction is very challenging at the intern level especially between intern and manager."
- "Crunched for time, lots of goals for end of internship. Intern event planning was a bit to concentrated in the scheduling."

- "Communication throughout the process was very good. I was never confused on next steps and never questioned how interviews went for me, as there was routinely a recap call from HR. I completed the entire interview process in under two weeks. I had the chance to speak with many individuals on the PD team as well as the VP of Product Development."
- "The interview process was very good, though it was longer than many other companies. Their standards are good, and all of the interns mesh well together, and it makes the program a very enjoyable experience."

- "Compensation is competitive for my position, and I additionally received a housing relocation stipend. There are also numerous amenities open to interns."
- "I am paid decently as an intern, however, it is definitely not as generous as many other places for mechanical engineers."
- "\$20 an hour for my internship, very competitive and includes summer hours."

- "The company accepts about a third of their interns as employees and although I am not graduating so I'm not eligible for a full time position, they offered me a position for next summer and the option to work remotely over the school year."
- "Many of the full-time employees started as interns. Hard to tell whether there are many job openings currently."
